

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the difference between each of the camps offered at Camp Grace?

DAY CAMP

- ➡ Our DAY Camps are geared toward ages **5-12** years
- ➡ Camps are offered from 8AM-1PM - - 4 days per session
- ➡ Day 4 (*final day* of camp), each camper will be dropped off/picked up at a local park
- ➡ Parents/Guardians are responsible for dropping off and picking up their camper(s) each day.
- ➡ We do **NOT** have extended care for our DAY (only) Campers

INTENSIVE CAMP

- ➡ Our INTENSIVE Camps are geared toward ages **8-14** years old
- ➡ This is an ***all day*** camp with the option to spend the night.
- ➡ If your camper is spending the night, they will need to be dropped off at **11AM** on Day 1 and picked up at **1PM** on Day 4.
- ➡ If a camper is not spending the night, it is the parent's/guardian's responsibility to drop off and pick up their camper each day.

DAY Camp Schedule

Day 1: 8AM-1PM
Day 2: 8AM - 1PM
Day 3: 8AM - 1PM
Day 4: 8AM - 1PM



INTENSIVE Camp Schedule

Day 1: 11AM-8PM
Day 2: 10AM - 8PM
Day 3: 10AM - 8PM
Day 4: 9AM - 1PM

NATIVE AMERICAN CAMP

- ➡ Our NATIVE AMERICAN Camps are geared toward ages **11-17** years old
- ➡ This is an overnight camp
- ➡ If your camper is taking the bus, departure is 8-10AM, if you are dropping off your camper, check in is at 2PM.
- ➡ Pick up at camp is at 2:30PM on the last day, the bus will return around 8PM.

WHAT IS THE "GRANT" AND WILL IT CHANGE HOW MUCH CAMP COSTS?

The AZ grant that was given to us last year has been **delayed** and the parameters for being awarded funds has been changed from last year. What this means is that we are applying for the grant - and hopeful - but we will not "officially" know the outcome **until May**. Be that as it may, we are registering campers as if the grant was approved at this time so we have time to prepare. Some changes from last year include the option to do "INTENSIVE camp". If your camper wants to participate in the overnight camp activities but does not want to spend the night, they now have that option. If they want to spend the night (which we highly encourage!) there is an additional \$200 overnight fee as this would be considered "extended care."

This grant covers as many sessions as you would like to register your camper for!

This year, we are charging a refundable deposit to minimize the amount of no-shows so that we can give your camper the best experience possible this summer. For our day campers, the **refundable** deposit is \$100 *per camper due upon registration. You will be refunded this deposit in one of the following instances:

- You cancel your camper's reservation at least **6 weeks** prior to the session start date
- Your camper attends their scheduled session (you will be refunded at the end of the session)
 - For our **Intensive** Campers, the deposit is \$200 *per camper due upon registration. You will be refunded this deposit as detailed above.
 - For our **Intensive Overnight** Campers, the deposit of \$200 covers the camper's extended overnight care and lodging and will only be refunded if you cancel the camper's reservation at least 6 weeks prior to the camper's start date.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

IS TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED?

For local campers, transportation is ***not** provided. For our valley campers, we have a bus service and plan to provide transportation from Mesa to Lakeside (estimate) **7AM** on Day 1, and returning to Mesa (est.) **5PM** on Day 4. We will send specific details as soon as we have them.

The bus (from Mesa to Lakeside) will be offered ***free*** for our campers - but **parents/guardians will be responsible** for camper transportation to and from the drop off/pick up location.



WHAT SHOULD MY CAMPER BRING TO CAMP?

For **Day** and **Intensive** campers, they should have **sunscreen** applied before camp. All campers need to wear their provided camp t-shirt and closed toed shoes, daily. Please remember to bring a **water bottle**, clearly labeled. It is recommended they also bring a **knapsack**/small backpack. Campers are encouraged to wear a **hat** - - must be worn ***all day!** ***Remember*** that all personal items must be clearly labeled. For all **Intensive** campers (spending the night) please refer to our "packing list" here. ***insert hyperlink**
